

From the 2008 Official Regulations and Playing Rules  
For Little League Baseball:

Page 49

Rule 1.17

Manufacturers have advised that altering helmets **in any way** can be dangerous. Altering the helmet **in any form**, including painting or adding decals (by anyone other than the manufacturer or authorized dealer) may void the helmet warranty. Helmets may not be re-painted and may not contain tape or re-applied decals unless approved in writing by the helmet manufacturer or authorized dealer.

From the 2008 Auburn Little League Safety Manual:

- Must be N.O.C.S.A.E. approved and approval seal must be visible.
- Hockey style catcher's helmets must have the N.O.C.S.A.E. approval embossed on the helmet.
- Must not be painted.
- Must have fully readable exterior warning label. (Labels available through the equipment coordinator).
- Must have the original padding.

\*\*\* No helmet may be altered in any way. Paint, markers, decals and/or stickers are not allowed on any piece of the helmet plastic \*\*\*
