The board of directors has been working hard for several months in preparation for the 2009/2010 season. We want to assist you in anyway possible. We offer programs from ages 5-18 in baseball and softball. As you read through the newsletter you will notice some changes that Little League has made during the off season. Please read the information carefully. We are all really excited for the season to start and to have fun playing ball!!!

New Pitching Rules for 2010

(d) Pitchers league age 14 and under must adhere to the following rest requirements:

- If a player pitches 66 or more pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 51 - 65 pitches in a day, three (3) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 36 - 50 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.

- If a player pitches 21 – 35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar day of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 1-20 pitches in a day, no (0) calendar day of rest is required.
Pitchers league age 15-18 must adhere to the following rest requirements:
 - If a player pitches 76 or more pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed.
 - If a player pitches 61 - 75 pitches in a day, three (3) calendar days of must be observed.
 - If a player pitches 46 - 60 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.
 - If a player pitches 31 – 45 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar day of rest must be observed.
 - If a player pitches 1-30 pitches in a day, no (0) calendar day of rest is required.

Club entrance). Be sure to arrive early as teams are formed on a first come first serve basis. If you are a signing up for the draft you may want to come on Tuesday to avoid the large lines.

This year, in an effort to increase young girl's participation in Little League Softball, we are offering an incentive. For every "new" softball player that signs up, the sponsoring player's (softball or baseball) league fee would be reduced by \$10.00 up to a maximum of \$30.00. Boys and girls, let's get some more fastpitch players on the field!

Bring your Documents

The requirement is the same as last season. It is necessary to show three documents to confirm that each player lives within the Auburn Little League Boundaries. These boundaries are the same as for the Auburn School District so there should be no confusion. We have the boundaries on our website for you to review. An example of some acceptable residency documents would include utility statements, driver's license, insurance documents and voter's registration card, all with your current address on them. Please feel free to check out our website, www.auburnlittleleague.com for additional information on Proof of Residency requirements.

In addition to proof of residency requirements, please plan to bring a copy of your player's

birth certificate It must be a certified copy issued by the state or county government. Please note that the following will not be acceptable as sole proof of birth Baptismal Certificate, Certificate of Blessing, Certificate of Dedication, Certificate of Circumcision, etc.; Hospital Certificate, photocopied records or passports.

Majors Baseball Tryouts

The boys Major Division try-outs for 11 & 12 year olds will be conducted at Auburn High School Memorial Stadium on **Saturday, February 13th and Sunday, February 14th.**

11-12 year olds with last name starting with A to K will start at 9:30AM

11-12 year olds with last name starting with L to Z will start at 1:00PM

(Sunday the 14th Start at 10:00AM for all players)

All players' ages 11-12 must try-outs for Majors unless returning to a Major Division team.

Please note that all players league age 12 must be drafted onto a Majors division or Junior League team. Parents of 12 year olds wishing their players to play down in AAA or AA must fill out a waiver form. The waiver request then must be approved by the Board and the District Administrator. The waiver request must be filled

out prior to try-outs, once a player has completed 50% or more of a try-out the player must then be drafted to a Majors division or Junior League team.

While only one try-out is required, all players are encouraged to participate in both Saturday and Sunday try-outs to maximize exposure to team Managers who will be selecting team members for the upcoming season.

AAA Baseball Tryouts:

The boys AAA Division try-outs for ages 9-12 will be conducted at Auburn High School Memorial Stadium on **Saturday, February 20th and Sunday, February 21st.**

9-12 year olds with last name starting with A to K will start at 9:30AM

9-12 year olds with last name starting with L to Z will start at 1:00PM

(Sunday the 21st Start at 10:00AM for all players)

All prospective players are encouraged to participate in the try-outs. **We encourage all 9 year olds to participate in the tryout session.** While only one try-out is required, all players are encouraged to participate in both Saturday and Sunday try-outs to maximize exposure to team Managers who will be selecting team members for the upcoming season.

Junior Baseball, Junior Softball and Major Softball:

Try-outs for both the Junior Baseball, Junior Softball & Major Softball will be conducted at **Auburn Memorial Stadium** on Saturday, February 20th and Sunday, February 21st. Junior Baseball tryouts on Saturday, February 20th will begin at 9:30

am followed by Junior and Major Softball try-outs at 1:00 pm. Tryouts on Sunday, February 21st for all Junior Baseball, Junior Softball and Major Softball players will begin at 10:00 am. All girls' ages 11-12 must try-out unless returning to a Major Division team. All baseball and softball players ages 12-16 not returning from a Junior or a Senior Division team are required to attend at least one try-out.

While one try-out is required, all players are encouraged to participate in both Saturday and Sunday try-outs to maximize exposure to team Managers who will be selecting team members for the upcoming season.

Senior Baseball Tryouts:

Try-outs for the Senior Baseball Team will be conducted at Brannan Park on Saturday, March 6th and Sunday, March 7th. Senior Baseball tryouts on Saturday, March 6th will begin at 10:00 am. Tryouts on Sunday, March 7th for all Senior Baseball will begin at 11:00 am. All prospective players are encouraged to participate in the try-outs. While one try-out is required, all players are encouraged to participate in both Saturday and Sunday try-outs to maximize exposure to team Managers who will be selecting team members for the upcoming season.

So we are asking all potential and willing candidates to apply by January 1st to allow the Board of Directors time to select the team managers. If you managed last year, please remember, no manager has 'tenure' from year to year. All interested parties need to apply each year.

If you are interested, here's what you need to do to apply for a manager position.

First, notify, in writing, **both** Dave Foster, manager coordinator via email at ldavef@comcast.net and Chris Fox crfoxden@comcast.net or mail your request via US Postal Service to PO Box 57, Auburn, WA 98071.

Second, you will need to complete both the Washington State Patrol Background Check and the Volunteer Application. Both forms are available at www.auburnlittleleague.com. The information can be typed and then printed for mailing to the PO Box along with a photocopy of your driver's license. They can be completed at sign-ups on January 16th/19th, although we do hope to have all manager set by then. Remember, these forms will also need to be completed by all coaches and volunteers who plan on assisting you this season.

Concussion Training for Managers and Coaches:

This year all Managers and Coaches will need to go through a training class on concussions. This training will take place at the Pre-Season Manager Meeting. At the completion of the training each Manager will receive player packet that they will be required to review with each player before the player will be allowed to practice and/or play in games.

Concussion Consent Form For all Players:

All parents and players will be required to read and sign the new Concussion Information and Consent Form. The form will be handed out at each Team Meeting. Please look for this form and review, sign and return to your manager. Players must have this form turned in before they can practice or play in games.

Score Keepers

New and Returning Umpires: Auburn Little League will be offering two umpire training sessions for the 2010 season. We would like all of our new and returning umpires and managers to attend at least one of these sessions to catch up on the new rule changes and to refresh your memory on field mechanics. All new umpires are required to attend a training session, we highly recommend attending both sessions as well as the umpire clinic offered by District 10.

A new Williamsport rule for this season is that we are required to have one (1) adult umpire on the field for all games, no exceptions. We will still have our youth umpires, but we must have at least one adult umpiring with them for every game. With this in mind, please remember that all managers are responsible for umpiring four regular season games. Two by the manager and two by an adult volunteer/coach associated with the manager's team. There will be a follow-up umpire meeting scheduled for all that have been approved and plan to umpire for Auburn Little League this year before the start of the 2010 season.
